For more then a half year you did not get a newsletter and we like to share with you again about some of our experiences.

Thank you for your prayers your friendship and all your financial support. We could not live here and serve the Lord and the people without your prayers and help. But the Lord has been faithful and supplied for all our needs.

In June, I was in Austria and Germany and we had a view blessed and encouraging evenings in different fellowships and cities, where Pastor Surprise shared the word of God with us. During a seminar in Austria I had also the opportunity to share about our relationship to Israel and there was a good response in repentance and intercession. It was an answer to prayer and I got another opportunity in August to share about Israel in Austria during a seminar. I was again in Europe because my parents had their 60th wedding anniversary. ("diamond wedding"). They are very thankful that they still have one another even so they both need the help of a caretaker all the time.

I have put in the attachment a little introduction of our vision and work in Jerusalem. We have been able to build a trust in Austria (Fellowship from Mount Zion), and we want to start also a trust in Israel. Hopefully we will be able to obtain more long time visas for Dietmar and other brethren in our house. Many of our friends needed to leave Israel, because their visa was not renewed. Our little prayer room is almost finished and our guests and we enjoy this room very much. Because it is the highest room in the house, we have a wonderful view over the new city of Jerusalem. Almost every morning during my prayer time I can see the sunrise.

Also this year in the summer we visited the former concentration and destruction-camp in Poland. The members of the group came from Israel, Germany, Poland, Austria and Switzerland. It was a privilege for our group that Yehudit Kriegel, her daughter Dafna and her grandchild Chen could come with us. Yehudit visited for the first time the former destruction-camp Belzec, where her mother was murdered. We are planning our next journey to the camps in Poland from the 21<sup>st</sup> until the 27<sup>th</sup> of July 2010.

Esther Manheim and her sister Yehudit Kriegel shared about our journey to Poland in September in the German Lutheran Church. Esther urged us that we would not forget the Holocaust ("Shoa") and would continue to be witnesses of

all what we have seen in Poland and heard from them. She also spoke about the spirit of Amalek and the great danger Israel is facing today.

Also in September we were able to visit and to pray with people on the island Patmos together with Pastor Surprise and his wife Tryphina. From there we came to Israel and both of them shared in different congregations. They have been a real encouragement to many people here.

From the 6<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> of May 2010, I will prepare another week of prayer and on the island of Patmos.

I don't know if you have heard Benjamin Netanyahu's speech to the UN in September. You can listen to it on Google under **Netanyahu UN speech**.

He asks clearly the Nations to make a decision: Will you decide to stand with or against terrorism? The public threats expressed by the President of Iran against Israel are taken very seriously here, after having gone through the Holocaust, not even a century ago. These threats include the whole Western World. Where will the Nations stand at this time? If we see the reaction of many Nations on the "Goldstein Report" we see that the majority of the Nations are ready to condemn firstly Israel. We hear of many rumours of war and Israel is preparing in giving new gas masks out in January 2010. Let us pray that our fellowships will not miss the times we live in and will be awake, pray and intercede.
